Dear Applicant,

Your alumni association has four awards totaling \$8,000 for the IVHS Class of 2011:

1. An Academic Scholarship of \$2,500.
2. The Bill Broeffle Vocational Scholarship of \$2,500.
3. A scholarship of \$2,500 in one of the above categories as designated by the screening committee.
4. The SOFCU'S Roni Rausch Broeffle Community Service Award of \$500. This award is given to an applicant who has demonstrated extraordinary involvement in community service activities during her/his high school career. All applicants will be considered for this award, and the recipient will be determined by the screening committee. (See item 3, page 1 of the Application.)

They are available to a senior graduating from Illinois Valley High School with a minimum GPA who is planning to continue his or her education in the fall of 2011 at a community college, state college, university, or trade school (vocational).

- Please read and follow the instructions carefully.
- Insert the Counselor/Teacher Evaluation Form[s], in whatever number you wish, in the center. In response to item 6, page 1, you may insert up to 3 letters of recommendation from persons not presently connected with the school or your immediate family.
- Insert grade transcripts in the center of the packet.
- Return the completed application to the **IVHS Counseling Office by May 1, 2011**

Please assure your parent[s]/guardian[s] that income information provided will be used only by the screening committee in confidence and is requested in order to evaluate need. That information will be eliminated from the voting packet if you become a finalist and your application is submitted to the voting corpus. You will find our voting procedure described in the Guidelines included here.

The chosen recipients will be notified by telephone on **Saturday, July 2, 2011** when the screening committee has counted the votes. The recipients will be announced and, if possible for them to be present, introduced at the Annual Alumni Breakfast at Jubilee Park in Cave Junction **Sunday, July 3, 2011**.

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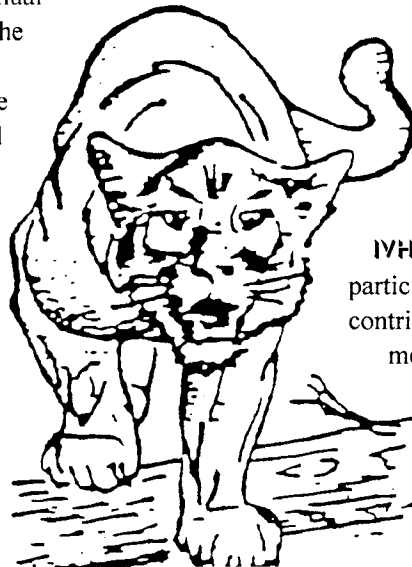

WHEN !! WHERE !!

Our main focus is the Annual Reunion Weekend. Each year on the weekend nearest July 4 some ten alumni classes hold reunions in the Illinois Valley. Over that weekend we sponsor events such as a dance, a golf tournament, Sunday Breakfast and Silent Auction—all for fun and for FuNdRaising! We've been known to join in IVHS Homecoming and the Holiday Basketball Tournament. Our fundraising projects have also supported student activities, and helped with landscaping.



HOW !!

The three scholarships of \$2,500 each in 2011 are funded by Reunion Weekend events, class fundraisers, and by direct donations. Each year's awards are based upon the success of these functions and the amounts to be given decided by a vote of the membership at the annual meeting in July. It is a popular program and unique in that each class and retired teacher has the opportunity to vote during Reunion Week (the week leading into our July 4th Reunion Weekend) for the scholarship recipients.

The \$500 SOFCU scholarship is an award for excellence in community service made possible by SOFCU's \$2,500 donation in 2010 to honor our deceased board member, Roni Rausch Broeffle '57, who was also a SOFCU board member. At their request this award will be given to an applicant each year for five years.

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SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

I. **Purpose.** This scholarship is established for the purpose of promoting and assisting higher education for needing and deserving applicants as set forth herein. The recipient[s] shall be selected by the Alumni Corpus according to these guidelines.

A. The recipient[s] must demonstrate academic performance and shall show at least a 2.5 grade point average in his or her grades over the four-year high school period. Participation in school, outside-of-school and/or community activities may be included in the application for consideration by the Screening Committee and the Alumni Corpus.

B. It is preferred that the recipient[s] have attended IVHS as a Freshman, Sophomore, Junior and Senior. It is required that the recipient[s] have received a diploma of graduation from Illinois Valley High School.

C. The financial need of the recipient[s] shall be considered and prescreened by the Screening Committee.

D. The relationship of the recipient[s] to an IVHS or KUHS alumnus shall be considered.

II. **Establishment of the Screening Committee and Alumni Corpus.** It is the responsibility of the board of directors of IVHS ALUMNI AND FRIENDS to appoint a screening committee of five (5) members over 21 years of age, serving a term of five years. The replacement of such member shall be made from the "alternate members' committee" which will serve in an apprenticeship, nonvoting, capacity for the actual screening committee members. There will be three members of the alternate committee who shall be appointed by the board of directors, and accession from the alternate committee to the screening committee shall be by approval of the board with due consideration given to background, desire, experience and other qualifications for the position. Prior to the convening of the screening committee, all members and alternates shall certify in writing that they are not more closely related by blood or marriage to a scholarship applicant than immediate family (i.e.,

brother, sister, son, daughter, grandchild, niece, nephew, aunt or uncle). Each member of the screening committee and the alternate committee shall serve at the pleasure of the board of directors and may be terminated for cause at any time. Should there be a vacancy on the screening committee, the board shall appoint a qualified member from the alternate committee to serve on the screening committee. If such is not possible, the board shall appoint a former member of the screening committee to serve a one-year temporary appointment.

A. **Duties of the Screening Committee.** The Screening Committee's duties shall include promoting the scholarship, screening the applicants, presenting the finalists to the voting corpus, counting the votes, and such other duties as directed by the board, including:

1. Prior to the week before Reunion Weekend, the Screening Committee Coordinator shall set a date for the screening committee to meet, electronically or in person, and determine if all five members of the screening committee will be present. If any of those five are not available to attend that meeting, the Scholarship Coordinator shall choose alternates from among the three previously named alternates so that there will be five (5) screening committee members at the meeting.

2. Prior to the Screening Committee Meeting each member of the Screening Committee shall have reviewed each application received. Prior to the weekend one week before Reunion Weekend, the Screening Committee shall meet to select the applicants to be interviewed, if any. At the conclusion of that meeting, the Screening Committee shall immediately notify by telephone each applicant selected for oral interview, if any, of the date, time and place of said interview[s].

3. Prior to the Saturday or Sunday immediately preceding Reunion Weekend, the Screening Committee may conduct oral interviews of applicants if deemed desirable. At the end of those interviews, if any, the Screening Committee will meet and determine finalists to be presented to the Voting

Corpus. It is anticipated that the number of finalists selected for presentation to the Voting Corpus will be one-third (1/3), or less, of the total number of applications received.

4. Following the selection of finalists to be presented to the Voting Corpus, the Screening Committee will meet and prepare the voting packets with secret ballots and envelopes, and make them available to the Voting Corpus by 9:00 a.m. on the Monday preceding Reunion Weekend.

5. Following the termination of voting on the Saturday of Reunion Weekend, at least three (3) members of the Screening Committee shall meet to count the votes, notify the Scholarship Award Winner, and invite him or her to be introduced the next day at the Annual Alumni Breakfast.

B. The Alumni Corpus shall consist of one person, one vote as follows:

1. The Screening Committee
2. One person from each Alumni Class from KUHS and IVHS that wishes to participate
3. Any retired Illinois Valley teacher who wishes to participate.

C. Duties of the Alumni Corpus: To pick up the applicant packets from the Screening Committee who will make them available beginning the Monday prior to Reunion Weekend, vote the enclosed secret ballot, and deposit it for compiling by Noon on the Saturday of Reunion Weekend.

1. It shall be the responsibility of each class to determine the person who will cast the one vote for that class. It is recommended that the classmate who was the chair in charge of preparing for the last previous reunion for that class, or the classmate who will be in charge of the next reunion, be chosen to cast that vote. Whatever procedure is used to determine this status, it is the duty of each class to notify a member of the Screening Committee the name of that voter. If no new notification is made, the person voting for that class shall continue in that capacity. Such notification shall be in writing. If classmates are unable to resolve who should vote the elector with the largest number of notarized recommendations from fellow classmates will vote.

2. A simple majority of the total votes cast shall determine the scholarship award. However, should there be ample funds available, the Screening Committee has the option of awarding more than one scholarship should there be a close vote of the Alumni Corpus. In the event of a tie, the Screening Committee shall have the option of either splitting the scholarship funds evenly or devising a method for breaking the tie.

III. Scholarship Award Amount. It shall be determined by a vote of the Active Members at the annual meeting of the membership the dollar amount to be awarded the following year. This decision shall be made and based upon the successful results of the recent past reunion activities which generate funds and donations made to that date.

IV. Other.

A. Application Procedures. Interested persons may apply by completing the application form provided by the Screening Committee and available through the Counseling Office at IVHS. The completed application, accompanied by a transcript of all four years of high school course work, shall be received in the IVHS counseling office by May 1.

B. Interview. Applicants shall make themselves available for an oral interview should one be requested. At the interview the applicant should be prepared to give the Screening Committee an update on current circumstances.

C. Award Notification. This scholarship shall be awarded for one (1) academic year only. The recipient may have until the fall term of the year following the year of presentation to begin and continuously use the award. The name of the recipient[s] shall be first announced at the Annual Alumni Breakfast held on the Sunday nearest the July 4th weekend. The recipient[s] will be notified by letter specifying the amount and conditions of the award.

D. Disbursement. A check in the student's name shall be forwarded to the recipient's chosen accredited school prior to the beginning of the fall term or semester. The school shall be instructed to apply the scholarship funds first to the student's tuition. However, where payment of the scholarship award directly to the educational institution will affect the recipient's overall financial aid package, payment may be made directly to the recipient after presentation of supporting documentation showing educational expenses incurred, but in such case funds paid directly to the recipient will be treated as taxable income by the IRS.
